The 2018 Street Improvements Project includes the reconstruction of various streets, storm sewer, and watermain throughout the City of Orono. This includes milling existing pavement sections and overlaying new bituminous pavement on Vine Place as well as Lyric Avenue from Livingston Avenue to Blaine Avenue. Additionally, mill and overlay work with storm sewer replacement and guardrail installation will be performed on Leaf Street from Bayside Road to Watertown Road and Forest Lake Landing. Work to be completed on West Lafayette Road includes watermain and water service replacement, reclamation of the bituminous surface, and construction of curb and gutter in some areas. Construction activities on Wildhurst Trail and Minnetonka Highlands Lane include storm sewer construction, curb and gutter and guardrail or portions of the roadway, and reclamation of the bituminous surface. Lastly, the northern end of Linden Lane will be realigned with some culvert replacement as well.

WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 17

Unfortunately the weather didn't cooperate this past week. Turf restoration began as well as driveway preparation on West Lafayette Road. Road building began on Friday on Linden Lane. Both Forest Lake Landing and Wildhurst Trail were prepped for the transition from utility work to road building next week.

Driveways on West Lafayette are scheduled for paving either Saturday or early in the week along with paving the base course on Linden Lane. Road construction will begin on Wildhurst Trail and Forest Lake Landing after Centerpoint completes a gas relocation. Curb will be replaced and miscellaneous concrete work will take place on Minnetonka Highlands Lane, Wildhurst Trail, and West Lafayette Road throughout the week.
