Old Crystal Bay Road, from Wayzata Boulevard to 6th Avenue North, is set to be fully reconstructed, widened, with turn lane additions to help improve traffic flow along the corridor. Work includes watermain replacement, storm sewer replacement and improvements, and full reconstruction of the pavement surface. Curb and gutter will be added to portions of the roadway along with sections of a center median and street lighting. Additionally, entrances to school parking areas will be reconstructed to better accommodate traffic flow.

WEEK OF OCTOBER 15

Final paving of trails and roadway was completed on Friday, with striping to occur on Sunday. Please try to avoid the project corridor as much as possible this weekend as project elements are attempted to be completed during the MEA break.



WEEK OF OCTOBER 22

Final grading, clean up, punch list items, and restoration will begin as soon as paving and striping is completed this weekend. The old street lights are being temporarily reinstalled while the new light poles are under production. The new poles will be installed as soon as they are delivered.

Thank you all for your cooperation throughout the project timeline. As things are wrapped up, be sure to keep an eye out for miscellaneous construction activity in the area.
