Re: 2021-2023 Sanitary Sewer Project  
City of Randolph, Minnesota

Dear Property Owner/Current Resident:

At the November 19, 2020 Special Council Meeting, the City Council voted to accept the \$13 million bond from the State of Minnesota for construction of a city sanitary sewer system and authorized Bolton & Menk to begin preliminary engineering. This project consists of installing sanitary sewer main under the street, replacing the street above the new sanitary sewer, extending sanitary sewer services to the right-of-way, and construction of sanitary holding ponds. This letter is simply intended to inform you of the upcoming project for which multiple opportunities for your input will be provided. Through the next few months the City will be gathering information on the project area for future decision making.

**Residents can expect to see Bolton & Menk surveyors, private utility locators, geotechnical boring rigs, and other workers around the area starting as soon as December 1, 2020 working on these tasks.**

Attached to this letter is two maps and a questionnaire. One of the attached maps illustrates Dakota County's status of individual septic systems in Randolph with green dots indicating a passing system, yellow indicating failure critical systems (possibility of failing any day), and failed systems in red. The second map depicts an approximate layout of the proposed sanitary sewer system. This proposed layout will be confirmed during the preliminary engineering process. The enclosed questionnaire is one resource used to identify infrastructure needs as observed by neighborhood residents as well as information that will help during the design and construction of the sanitary sewer. Your time and effort to complete and return this questionnaire is much appreciated. Following collection of this information, this winter and spring the City will host neighborhood meetings, for which a separate mailing will be sent, to inform residents about the project and collect additional input.

Please return the enclosed questionnaire by **January 1, 2021**. The questionnaire can be dropped off at Randolph City Hall or mailed to 4365 292<sup>nd</sup> Street East P.O. 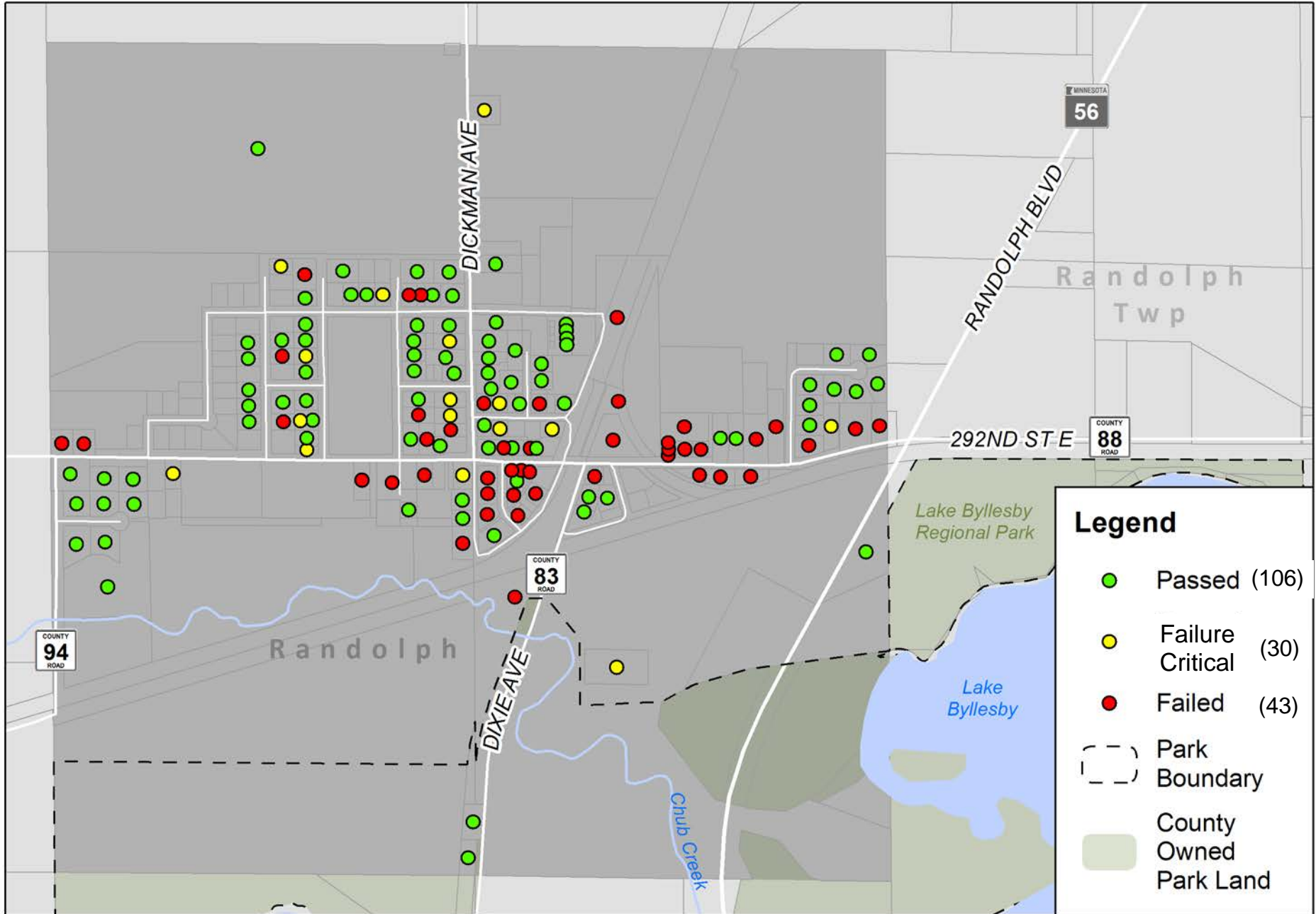

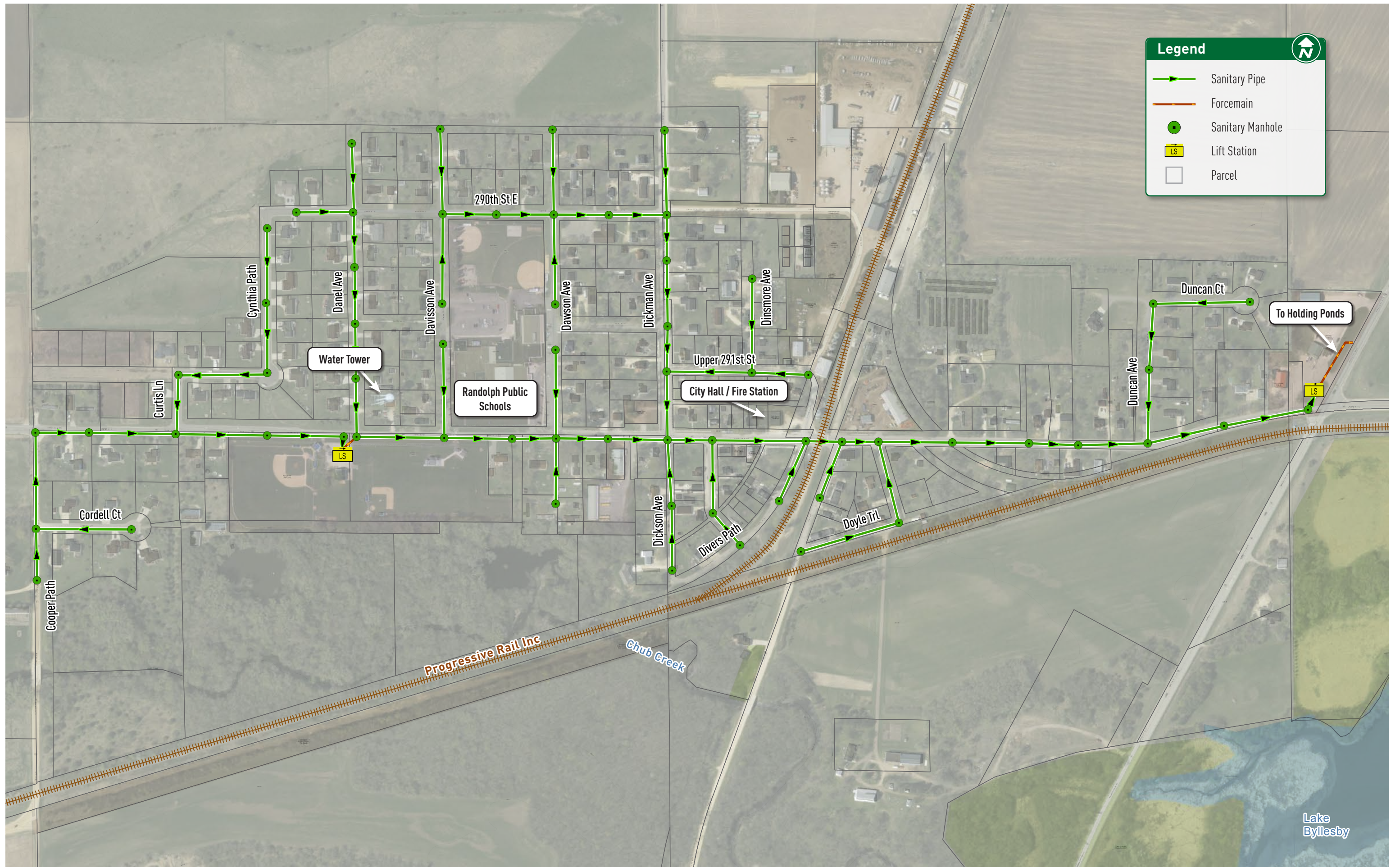
