

County Highway 88 -Roadway Improvement Project

Introduction:

Dakota County is proposing to reconstruct CSAH 88 from about 800' west of County Road (CR) 94 (Cooper Path) to Trunk Highway 56, in the City of Randolph. This project will also improve safety, traffic operations, drainage, and pavement quality. The proposed reconstruction will include a 3-lane road section with a center left turn lane, curb and gutter, sidewalks, and drainage improvements.

Purpose and Need:

The purpose of the project is to construct a city-wide sanitary sewer system. To take advantage of cost efficiencies and resident coordination, the County intends to reconstruct CSAH 88 at the same time.

Project includes:

The proposed reconstruction will include a 3-lane road section with a center left turn lane, curb and gutter, sidewalks, and drainage improvements.

Anticipated timeline:

Design and right of way: October 2022-May 2023
Construction start: May 2023

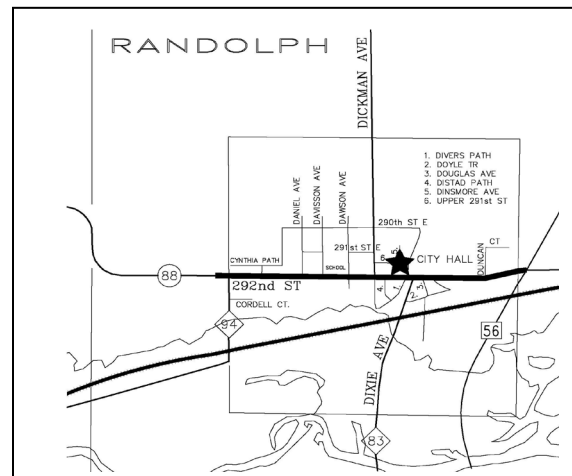
