

This project is intended to begin the transformation of the Broadway Avenue corridor (from Civic Center Drive to 13th Street North) into a significant multi-modal gateway to downtown Rochester and the Destination Medical Center (DMC) Development District. The Broadway Avenue Corridor Study, completed in 2015, set the stage for future improvements that will occur.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Construction on North Broadway between 11 Street and 13 Street continues, with this section of the roadway completely closed to vehicle traffic. Local traffic and business access for North Broadway in this section will now need to utilize side streets and the mid-block alleys to reach their destinations.

Taking a walk or a cycle around Silver Lake? Please note the trail on the south side is closed from 12 Street NE and over the North Broadway Bridge. The pedestrian/cyclist detour shown below will be in place for approximately 2 more weeks. As soon as



construction moves out of the 13 Street NW intersection, the Ped/Bike detour will shift along Silver Lake Drive and the North Broadway Bridge. Stay tuned for that update!

The Elton Hills Bridge project has been delayed, and will start in October 2021. This will ease some of the restrictions around the north end of the Broadway project.
