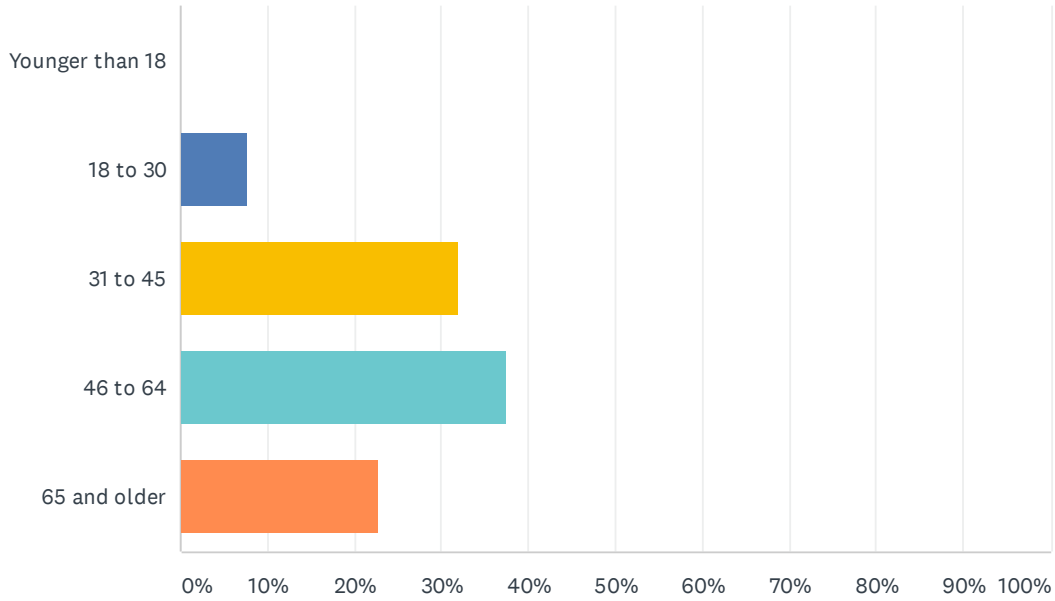


Q1 What is your age?

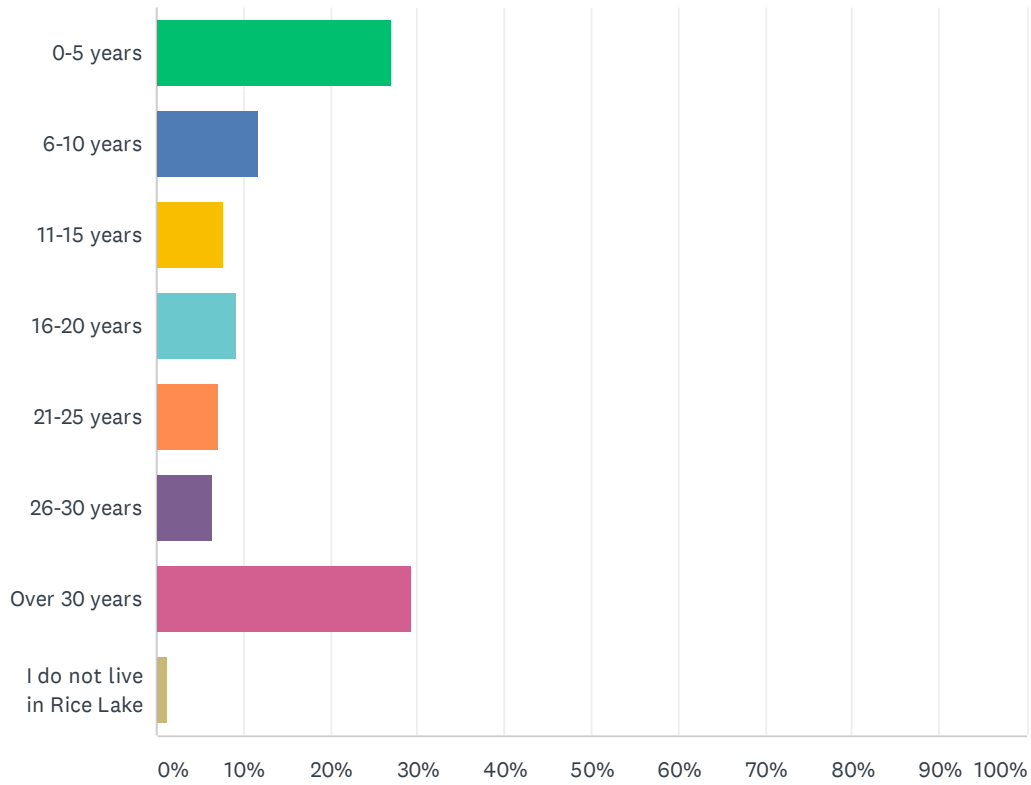

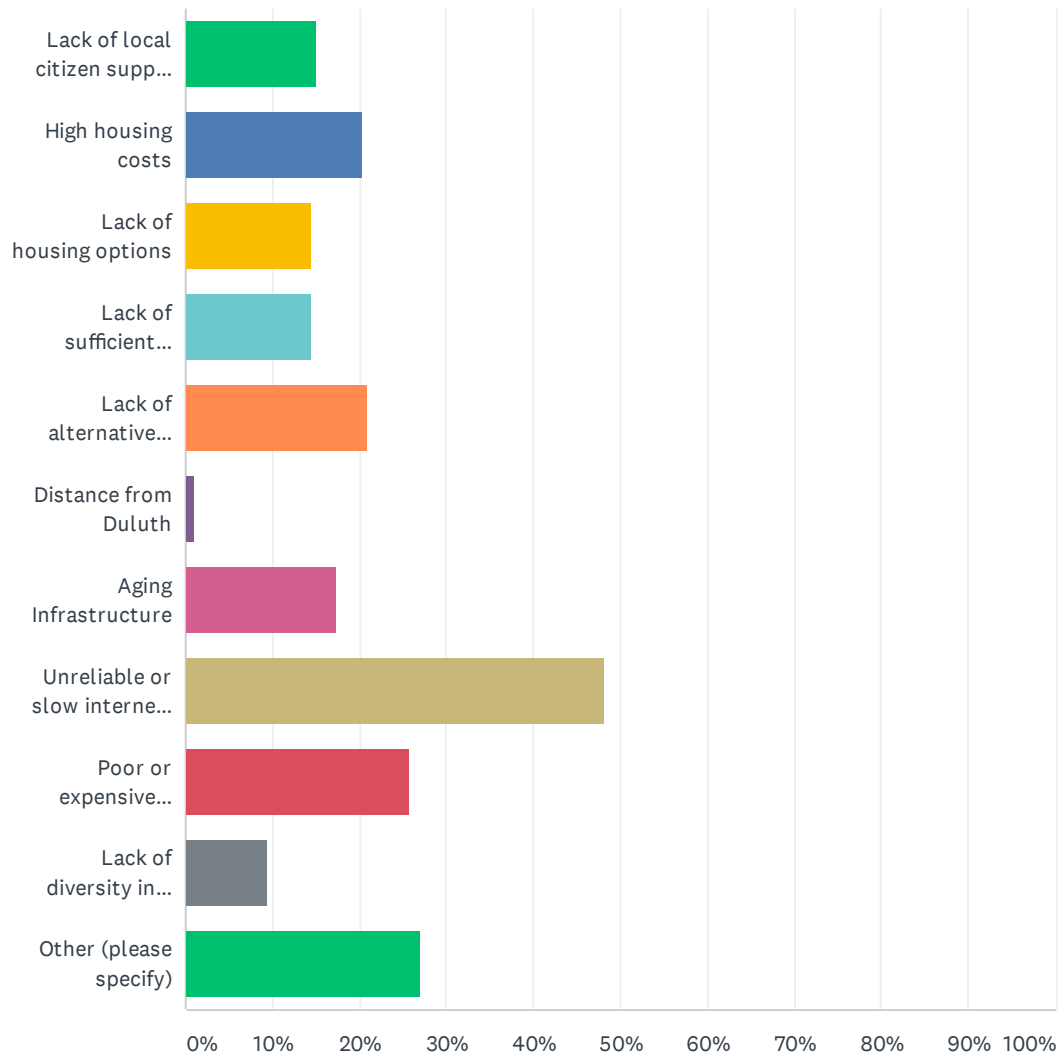

Q9 Is there a need for more housing in Rice Lake?

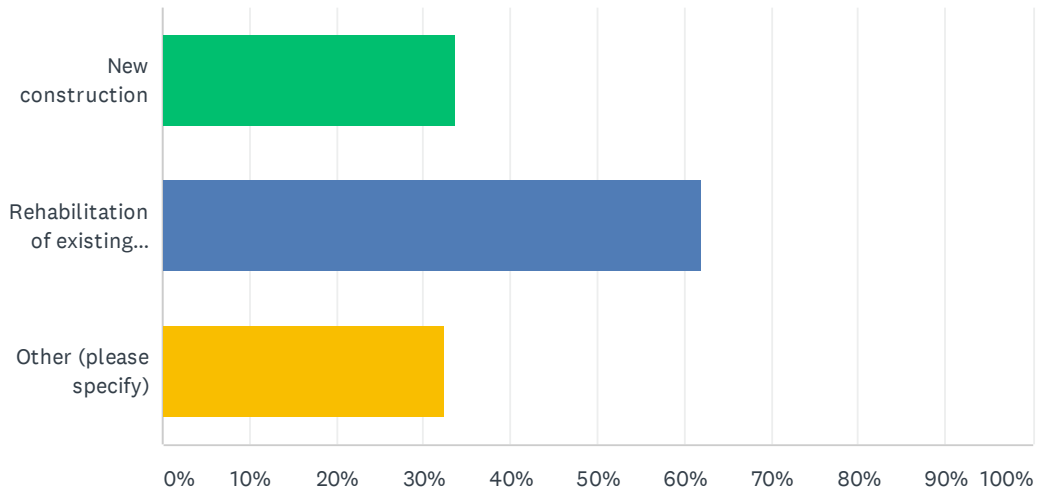

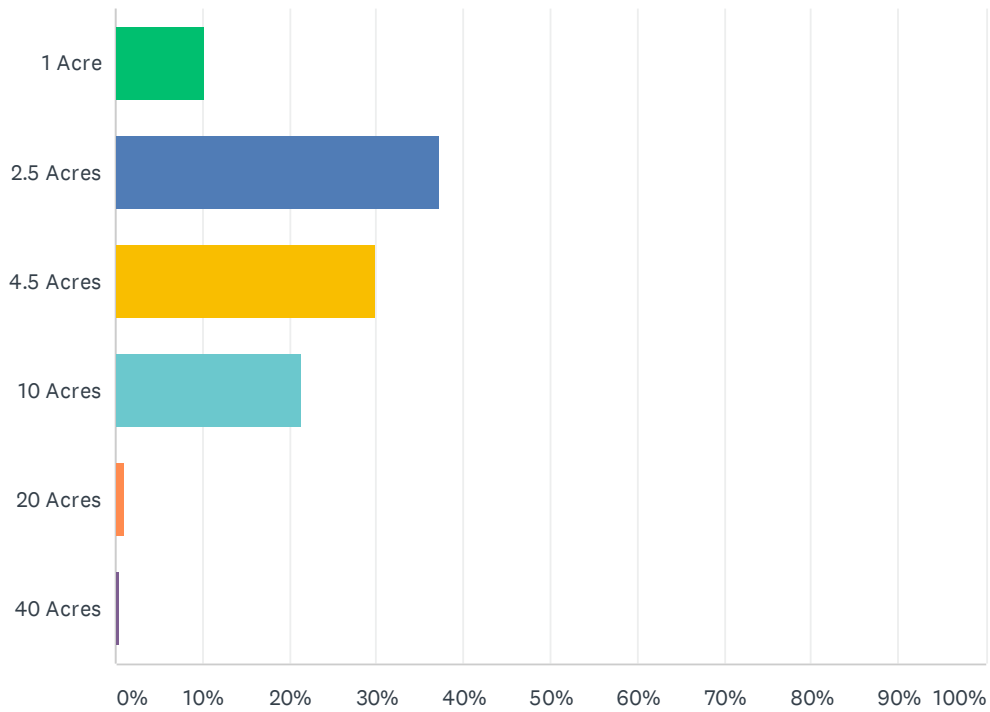

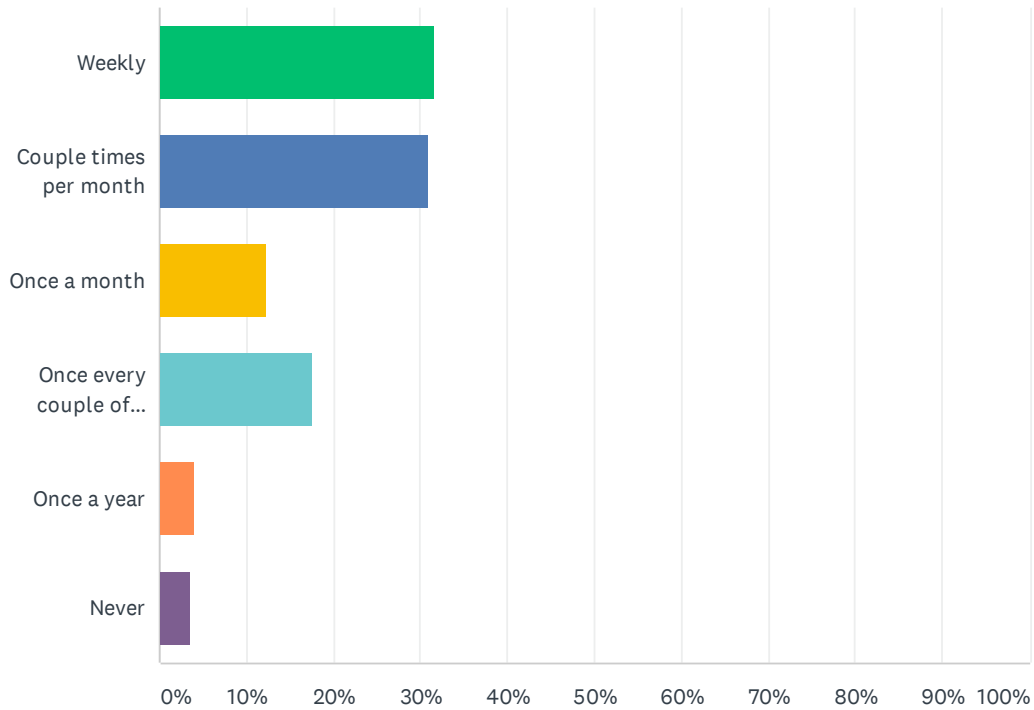

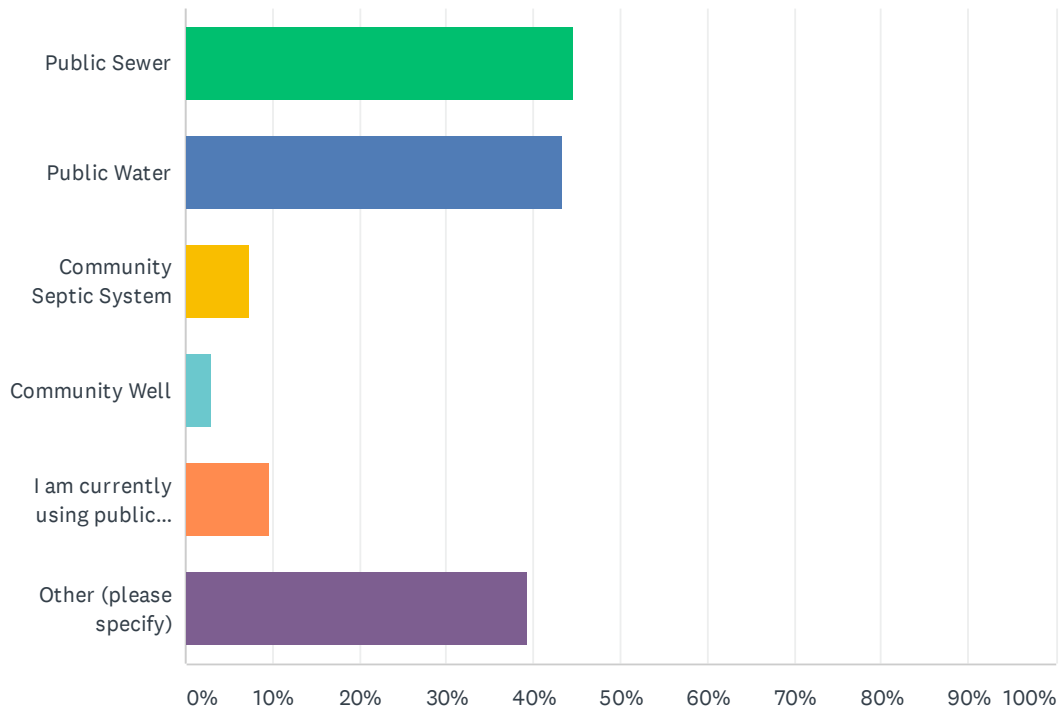
