Duluth/Superior MIC conducted an Intersection Control Evaluation for Rice Lake Rd and Martin Rd



Evaluation was covered in the newspaper and generated public interest.

Rice Lake Township passed resolution prohibiting roundabouts in Rice Lake

Developers request additional access to Rice Lake Rd from St. Lous County. These request are denied because Rice Lake Rd is a controlled access corridor.

Rice Lake is incorporated as a city



St. Louis County proposed to meet with the City to discuss a potential planning study for the Rice Lake Rd corridor.



St. Louis County met with the City Council in October 2018 to propose a joint planning effort for the Rice Lake Rd corridor.

St. Louis County and City met several times to discuss the planning study but did not proceed at that time.

Intersection Control Evaluation Study completed at four intersections including recommendations and concept layouts.

- City was key partner and served on the Project Management Team.
- Feb. 7 Presentation of recommendation to the city council generated questions by council and public.
- · March 22 City Council meeting included a more in depth dicussion of issues and sought public input.
- Sept. 25 Another public meeting was held to seek public input on layout.

May 2021 Meeting between St. Louis County and Rice Lake Mayor on another topic leads to conversation about a desire to re-engage on the

Rice Lake Rd corridor.



Revised plan to develop a more comprehensive corridor that includes public investment in roads, utilities, trails, and sidewalks to support future growth while addressing capacity and safety issues.
