



**RESOLUTION 22-11**  
**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INTERSECTION CONTROL EVALUATIONS**  
**ON THE RICE LAKE ROAD (CSAH 4) COMMERCIAL CORRIDOR**

**WHEREAS**, St. Louis County and the City of Rice Lake have cooperatively performed Intersection Control Evaluations on the Rice Lake Road (CSAH 4) corridor at the intersections of Ridgeview Road (CR 694), West Calvary Road (CR 234), Martin Road (CSAH 9) and West Tischer Road (CSAH 2); and

**WHEREAS**, the Intersection Control Evaluation report recommends construction of left-turn and right-turn lanes on Rice Lake Road (CSAH 4) at the intersection of Ridgeview Road (CR 694), and

**WHEREAS**, the Intersection Control Evaluation report recommends construction of a single-lane roundabout on Rice Lake Road (CSAH 4) at the intersection of West Calvary Road (CR 234); and

**WHEREAS**, the Intersection Control Evaluation report recommends construction of a single-lane roundabout on Rice Lake Road (CSAH 4) at the intersection of Martin Road (CSAH 9); and

**WHEREAS**, the Intersection Control Evaluation report recommends no improvements at this time on Rice Lake Road (CSAH 4) at the intersection of West Tischer Road (CSAH 2); and

**WHEREAS**, the four Intersection Control Evaluation reports have been presented to the Rice Lake City Council, copies of which were before the council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Rice Lake approves and supports the recommendations as presented in the reports made by the Intersection Control Evaluations performed on the Rice Lake Road (CSAH 4) corridor at the intersections of Ridgeview Road (CR 694), West Calvary Road (CR 234), Martin Road (CSAH 9) and West Tischer Road (CSAH 2), and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City of Rice Lake recognizes that the approved intersection control types shall form the basis of and be incorporated into the preliminary and final design of the Rice Lake Road (CSAH 4) corridor.
