


## Southview Boulevard Improvement Project Project Update – May 11, 2018

The contractor will be installing a temporary watermain pipe early in the week of May 14 to install new watermain along Southview Blvd. Residents will still have access to their water during this process, which will last about 2 to 3 weeks until the new main is installed and the temporary system is removed.

The temporary water service lines are being installed to provide clean and potable water to your home while new water main is being constructed within the roadway. The temporary pipe will go above ground and will run along the end of your driveway. The pipe will be either buried or ramped over with gravel or boards in order to maintain access to your driveway.

When temporary water installation begins, the City will coordinate turning off your water supply to the old main by shutting off the water valve in your front yard. If this valve is not accessible, the contractor may need to access your home to turn off your water supply to the old main, using the shut-off valve shown below, and connect to the temporary system. The Contractor will work with residents and their schedules to access the shut-off valve inside the house, if needed.

Future instructions will be sent out when the new watermain is reinstated and the temporary system is removed. The diagram below shows an example of a typical water meter installation:
