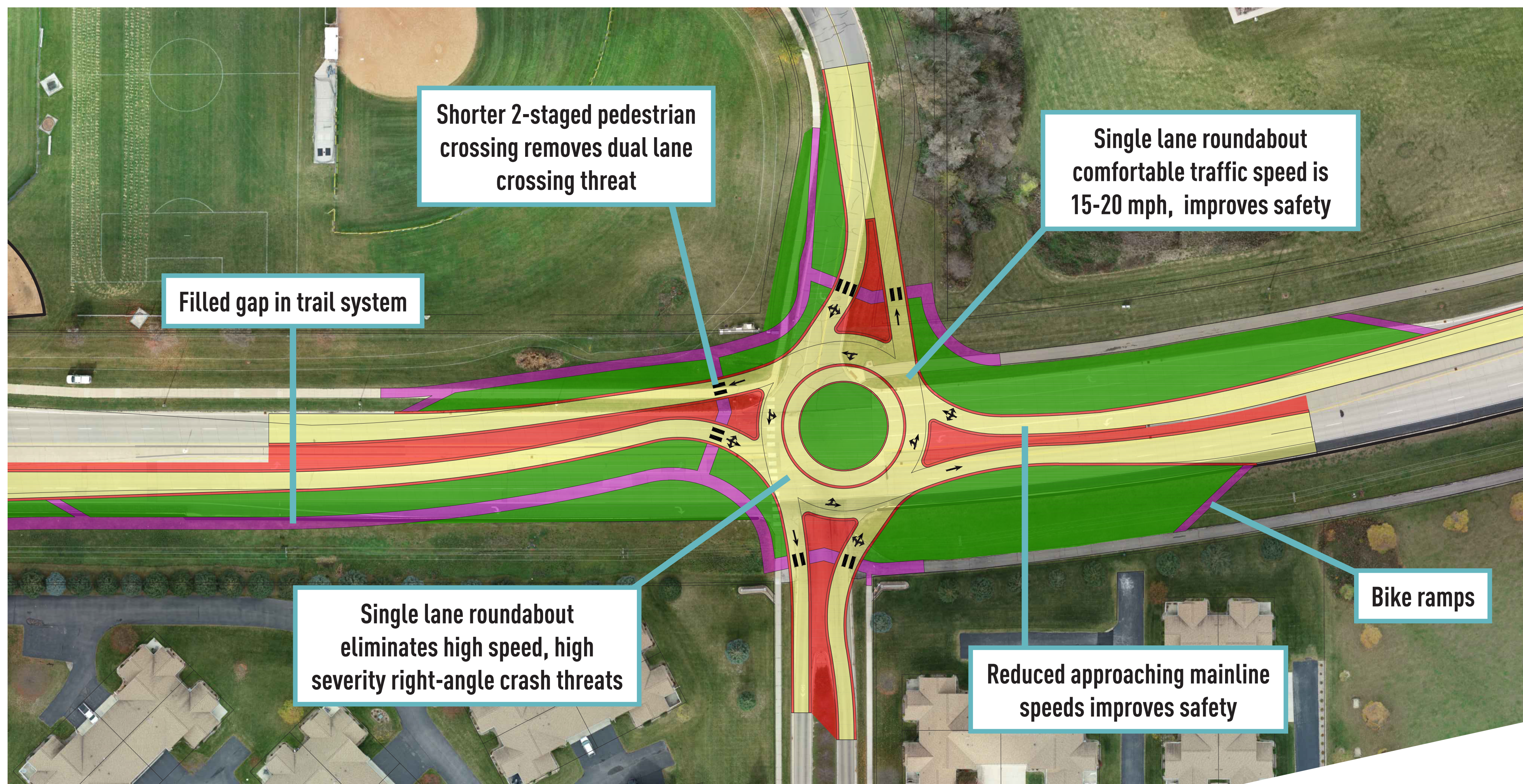

REACHING THE PREFERRED LAYOUT

The **Preferred Viola Road NE & Cassidy Drive NE Layout** consists of single-lane roundabout and trail facility components that work cohesively to best address concerns and together achieve all Key Objectives. Selection of the Preferred Layout was guided by the six Key Objectives identified by the project team.



DECEMBER 2007

The project team completed the first Intersection Control Evaluation (ICE) Report for the intersection. The project was put on hold after completion of the report.

NOVEMBER 2017

The Viola Road/Cassidy Drive project begins again with new traffic counts collected at the intersection.

DECEMBER 2017

At their December meeting, the Rochester City Council added the Viola Road/Cassidy Drive project to the City's 6-year Capital Improvements Plan (CIP).

AUGUST 2021

The project team completed an updated ICE Report for the intersection. The report recommended a single-lane roundabout as the preferred alternative.

FEBRUARY 2022

The first project open house was held virtually. A total of 58 participants attended the events, leaving 106 comments.

MAY 2022

The second project open house is now being held in-person as well as online. Visit the project website to participate virtually.

JUNE 2023

Construction activities are anticipated to begin after the last day of school and conclude before school begins in the fall.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

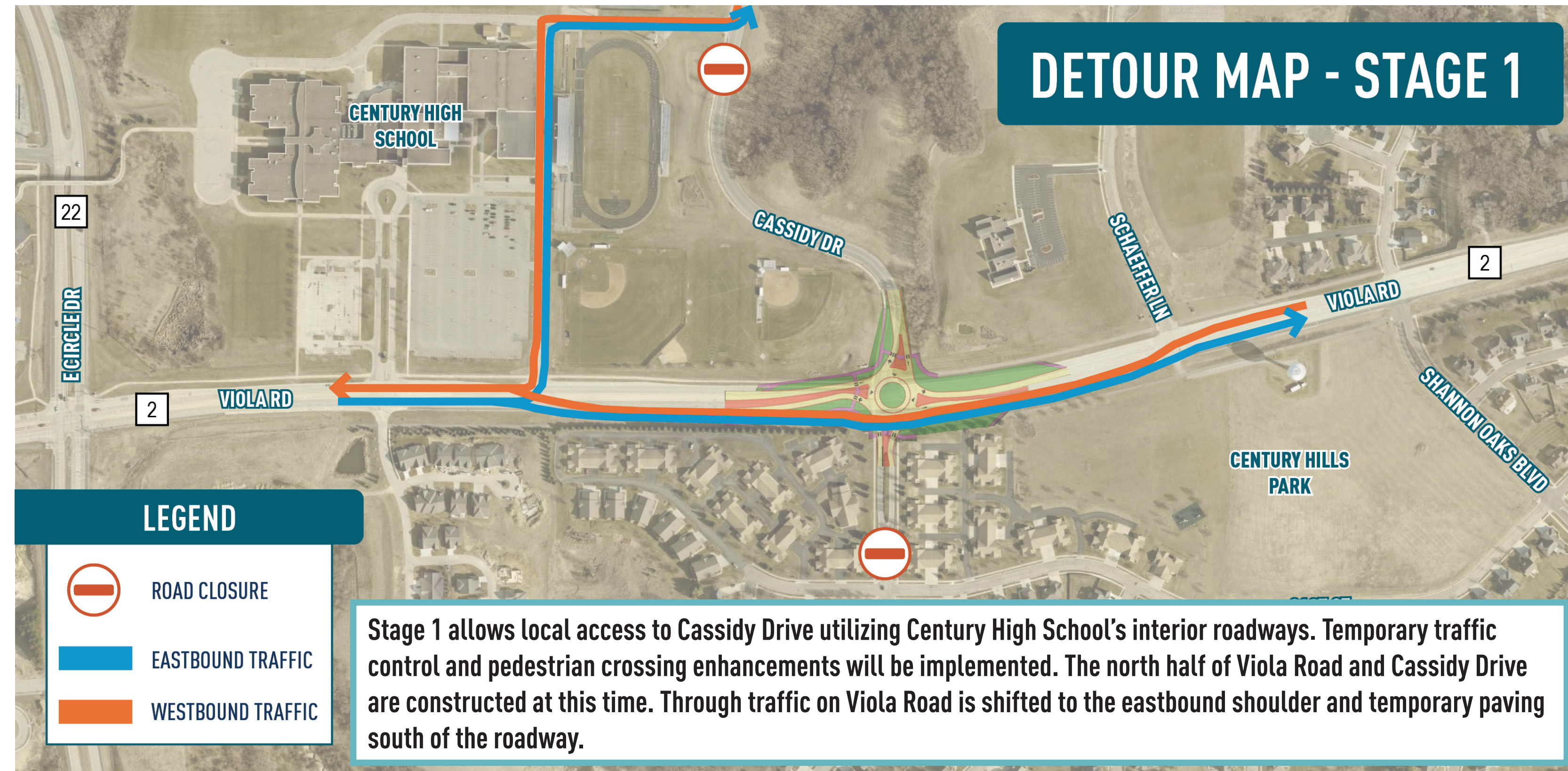
- » Construction will take place during the summer of 2023.

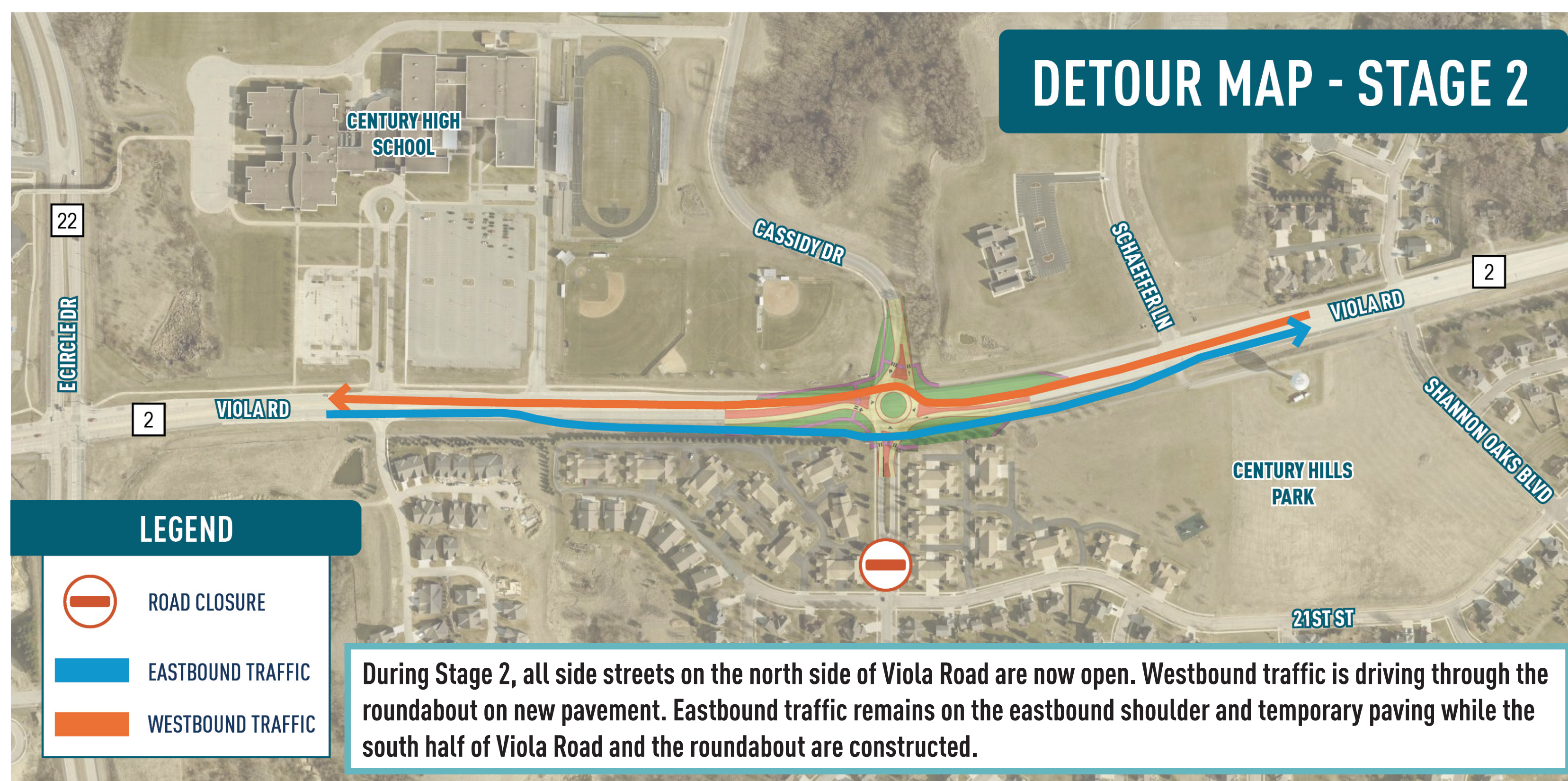
