Overview


The City of Wabasha wants to hear from you! The City is planning for the reconstruction of streets and utilities within portions of the downtown in the summer of 2023. The improvements will consist of the full reconstruction of street, sanitary sewer, water main, and storm sewer. The map below shows the general project area.

The City will be hosting an open-house style meeting for any interested property owners, residents, and business owners. **The meeting will be held at the National Eagle Center Main Street location on Thursday, May 26th from 4:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M.** The meeting will provide an opportunity for residents and business owners to learn about the project and provide their input on current needs or concerns within the corridor and provide input on potential improvements.

Community Engagement Schedule Street & Utility Improvements and Downtown Streetscape Plan



The City of Wabasha is planning for the reconstruction of streets and utilities within portions of the downtown in the summer of 2023. In conjunction with this project, the city will be completing planning tasks that help to guide the streetscape aesthetic in and around the downtown. These tasks will be completed in parallel with the street project, and the outcomes captured in the Downtown Streetscape Plan. See the specific project website for more details.

2023 STREET & UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS

The street improvements will consist of the full reconstruction of streets, sidewalks, sanitary sewer, watermain, and storm sewer.

- Bridge Avenue from 4th Grant Blvd W to Main Street W
- Main Street W from Bridge Avenue to Pembroke Ave
- Pembrooke Avenue from Main Street W to 4th Grant Blvd W

DOWNTOWN STREETSCAPE PLAN

around the downtown:

- Wayfinding & community entry signage
- Downtown identity & site ammenities
- · Enhancing underutilized spaces under the bridge
- Strengthening the connection to beach park
- Enhancing trail connectivity along the river



Project open houses will be tailored to the reconstruction project and those directly impacted by the work. Streetscaping elements will be defined with the Streetscape Plan and incorporated into the final design.

You can provide input through participation in the visual preference survey and attending the public open house. The Streetscape Steering Committee will be reviewing public input and providing a recommendation to the City Council.
