

2023 STREET & UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS


The street improvements will consist of the full reconstruction of streets, sidewalks, sanitary sewer, watermain, and storm sewer.

- · Bridge Avenue from 4th Grant Blvd W to Main Street W
- · Main Street W from Bridge Avenue to Pembroke Ave
- · Pembrooke Avenue from Main Street W to 4th Grant Blvd W

DOWNTOWN STREETSCAPE PLAN

The streetscape plan will consider the following elements in and around the downtown:

- Wayfinding & community entry signage
- · Downtown identity & site ammenities
- · Enhancing underutilized spaces under the bridge
- Strengthening the connection to beach park
- Enhancing trail connectivity along the rive



Project Funding

Project Cost Estimate: ~\$6.3 Million

- Based on planning-level estimates
- MnDOT Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) Funding \$1.25 million
- Wabasha County Contribution \$450,000
- City is seeking additional financing for utility improvements
- Project funding will include assessments.

What to Expect During Construction

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

- May to November 2023
 Final Pavement Lift in 2024
- General Working Hours
 Monday Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
 Saturday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
 No Work on Sunday
- Project Phasing will be considered
- Staging within each phase is determined by the Contractor
- Weekly construction updates





What to expect during construction

CONSTRUCTION ACCESS

 Access will be provided to your property each morning and night outside of construction hours (sometimes in gravel)

 Your driveway will be closed for up to 7 days

Concrete curb & gutter / driveway installation
Park on street in front of home

What to Expect During Construction

UTILITY SERVICE

- Temporary Water Service
 Plastic pipe running yard to yard
 Service through hose spigot
- Short term outages may occur during connection to the newly constructed utility
- There are no planned longterm interruptions





What to Expect During Construction



MAIL

Temporary Mailboxes will be installed

Garbage & Recycling

- Service will be on the normal schedule
- Residents must roll bins to the curb, as usual
- Contractor will work with the hauler to collect bins

Landscaping & Irrigation

- Any landscaping, invisible fences, irrigation lines within the ROW may be removed as part of construction
- The City will use only sod to restore disturbed ROW


