## Popular feedback themes:



Support for the proposed improvements.



Traffic backups occur at Boston Scientific/W Fish Lake Rd. intersection.



Request for a right and left-turn lane into Shadow Creek Rd.



Request for wildlife signage due to frequent deer crossings.



Desire for right-turn lane into Tarleton Crst. N.



Desire for better lighting along the corridor.



Request for pedestrian-activated flashing sign at Zanzibar Ln. crossing.



Concern that development planned in western Maple Grove will increase traffic and speeding.



Request for advanced signage/pedestrian-activated flashing sign at Ranchview Lane crossing.



Many intersections have poor sight lines.



Appreciation for planned measures to reduce speeding but concerns they may not be sufficient. Additional improvements suggested include:

- Roundabouts
- Stop signs
- Speed limit reduction
- Increased police presence



Request to consider alternate roadway layouts:

- Converting the roadway to 3 lanes with a center turn lane.
- Converting the roadway to 5 lanes with a center turn lane.
