Overview

The City of Willmar is undertaking a construction project to improve the city streets and utilities on Irene Avenue SE, Augusta Avenue SE, & Mary Avenue SE. The project includes road construction, sanitary sewer improvements, water system improvements, and storm sewer improvements.

Construction

With the construction there will be slight delays in traffic and alterations to streets adjacent to the project area. There is a pipe currently running down Olena Avenue SE and is utilized to bypass pump sanitary sewer to accommodate the flow during the first phase of construction. We ask that you refrain from utilizing on street parking during this time.

The tentative schedule is to be complete with bypass pumping by May 26,2023. As bypass pumping is complete, we will remove the bypass pipe and traffic on Olena Avenue SE should resume with minimum interruptions.
