

2023 Street & Utility Improvements Sump Pump Information

The new streets will contain six-inch subsurface drains installed at the bottom of the roadway section to remove subsurface moisture and reduce the risk of frost heaves. These subsurface drains will be located one-foot behind back of curb and will run parallel with the street. These subsurface drains will give residents an opportunity to connect their sump pump discharge lines to avoid the surface discharge that commonly occurs causing pavement deterioration. The sump pump line will be stubbed out 5 feet from back of curb. If new sidewalk is being constructed, the sump pump line will extend to the back side of the sidewalk. As construction progresses, the location of these sump connections will be coordinated by the on-site inspector with the homeowner.

Roof drains are not allowed to be connected to the subsurface drains.
