### PROJECT STATUS AND UPCOMING WORK

- Work completed this past week included watermain construction on 5<sup>th</sup> Street West and sanitary sewer construction on 269<sup>th</sup>, starting from the deep manhole between addresses 13045 and 13125 and working east past 13045 and 12965.
- Starting the week of May 15, the contractor will begin again at the deep manhole and work their way west, and hope to install approximately 1,000 feet of sewer. This will take them past addresses 13125, 13148, 13205, 13206, and ending somewhere around 13210 and 13285.
- Construction progress is always dependent upon weather and other factors and can vary from what is estimated.
- We know the construction work creates extreme inconveniences for getting to and from your properties. Thank you for your patience while the work is underway.
- Please see to the care of children and other vulnerable individuals during construction and be aware of the movement of construction equipment while traveling so that everyone will be safe until the work is completed.
