The City of Willmar is undertaking a construction project to improve the city Block 22 Parking Lot and the Sunrise Path. The project includes parking lot reconstruction and path reconstruction.



The following is a tentative schedule for the construction in each project area:

Block 22 Parking Lot Improvements:

- Removal of concrete curb & gutter and parking lot surface will start on May 24th and continue through the week of May 29th. We request that all vehicles be removed from the parking lot the evening of May 23rd, 2023
- Construction of the improved Block 22 Parking Lot is tentatively scheduled to be complete end of June 2023.

Sunrise Path Improvements:

- Removal of the bituminous path will start the week of June 5th, 2023.
- Construction of the improved Sunrise Path Project is tentatively scheduled to be complete end of June 2023.

In the interest of safety, the Block 22 Parking Lot and Sunrise Path will be closed to public during construction. If construction is delayed due to inclement weather, assume it will proceed the following day.
