CURRENT WORK

Ongoing Work:

• Excavation and placement of aggregate base for street and sidewalk construction will continue until about May 29th.



UPCOMING WORK

Anticipated Work for early June:

• Curb and Gutter and Sidewalk Construction – the exact schedule is not determined yet.

There will be times when the construction work disrupts driveway access. These will be minimized as much as possible, but there will be work that requires you to remove your vehicles from your driveway and park away from construction activity. You will be notified by the Contractor or the Construction Project Representative in advance of this requirement. The Contractor hopes to complete the bulk of the work by the end of June, depending on weather and hopefully good health by all involved in the project.

Also, since school is not in session and construction can be an attractive nuisance, please see to the safety of children during construction.
