### CURRENT WORK

#### Current Work:

- Concrete Curb and Gutter Construction has been completed.
- Fine grading of the aggregate base for paving will be occurring the week of June 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Curb and gutter will be ramped with aggregate at driveways so they can be utilized the week of the 15<sup>th</sup> as well.



### UPCOMING WORK

#### Anticipated Work for later June:

- Bituminous paving is currently scheduled for the week of June 22<sup>nd</sup>. Alleys will also be paved at this time.
- After the bituminous base course has been placed, the contractor will work on concrete sidewalks and driveways as well as boulevard restoration.
- Once the boulevard restoration work has been completed, the bituminous wear course will be placed. The schedule for this is not fixed at this time.
