# PROJECT STATUS AND UPCOMING WORK

- During the week of June 12<sup>th</sup>, the contractor will be completing watermain work on Monday and Tuesday by installing the remaining hydrants on the project.
- After completing the watermain work, they will be installing the remaining sanitary sewer main between addresses 13365 and 13557. All underground work will be completed by the end of the week.
- The contractor will be bringing their grading crew in to begin work on building the roadway. This will require additional excavation to widen the roadway and make room for the aggregate and pavement sections.
- With multiple crews on site, there will be considerable activity on the roadway. Please be prepared for interruptions to access to your residences. Residents will be informed of impacts in the morning by the contractor or inspector. Thank you for your patience.
- Please see to the care of children and other vulnerable individuals during construction and be aware of the movement of construction equipment while traveling so that everyone will be safe until the work is completed.
