PROJECT STATUS AND UPCOMING WORK

- The grading of the roadway and placement of aggregate base will be completed before the weekend.
- Next week the placing of the first lift of bituminous pavement will start at 7 a.m. Monday morning. They plan to hopefully finish it all in one day, but it may take two days to complete.
- The paving work will affect access to driveways and streets, so
 please be aware of the additional construction traffic that is
 occurring and follow the instructions of the construction
 workers.
- Additional work next week will be the raising of manhole castings and completion of grading work in the roadway ditches.
- In addition, the grading work and construction traffic has generated considerable dust on the project. Please be aware that due to the current dry conditions, the City is having to manage their water supply very closely, which limits the amount of water available for dust control.
- Please see to the care of children and other vulnerable individuals during construction and be aware of the movement of construction equipment while traveling so that everyone will be safe until the work is completed.
